after which time entries cannot be accepted, altered, canceled, or substituted except as provided for in the Chapter 11, Section 6 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows* published by the American Kennel Club. Express entries must be sent to 18780 Munsee Road, Apple Valley, CA 92307 and must include delivery release signature.

Entries may be sent as an attachment to email. Pay for the entry fees via PayPal to the account for PARRKEES@mac.com. Add \$4 per entry form.

- 1. Owner responsibility.** The Club and/or its Trial Secretary assume(s) no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or agent of the owner.
- 2. Transfers and Change of Entry.** As per Chapter 1, Sections 15 & 16, transfer and change of entry must be made in writing at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial.
- 3. No refund of entry fees (exception: bitch in season).** Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete because it has been entered incorrectly. There will be no refund of duplicate entries. If, because of extreme weather conditions, riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the trial, no refund of entry fee shall be made. Returned checks will be charged a \$25 return check fee. Apple Valley Kennel Club offers a refund of the entry fees for bitches in season, minus a \$10 processing fee. The trial secretary must be notified in writing at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial.
- 4. Declination of entries.** Apple Valley Kennel Club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or any other cause, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against Apple Valley Kennel Club or any official thereof.
- 5. Entry Acknowledgement.** If exhibitor's ticket and judging program are not received within a reasonable time prior to the trial, notify the Trial Secretary at (760) 946-9048. Consult the judging program for time of judging.
- 6. Trophies and Prizes.** All trophies and prizes must be claimed in the ring or at the Trophy Table. All trophies must be claimed the day of the trial. None will be mailed. The club reserves the right to substitute, if necessary a trophy of equal or greater value for any trophy offered.

7. **During the hours of judging** owners are to be on call, and have their dogs ready to bring into the judging ring promptly, in order that the judging will not be delayed. Dogs need only be present for their judging. Dogs not needed for further judging may be excused. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class. Owners of dogs or the handlers of the dogs alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings. This means it is not the responsibility of the ring steward, nor of any agent of the show-giving club to locate any dog, its owner or handler, when the dog's presence is needed in a judging ring. It should be understood by every exhibitor and handler that waiting for dogs to be brought into the ring is a courtesy extended to the owner or handler of the dog. There is no rule of this club nor of The American Kennel Club that requires a judge to wait for an owner or handler to bring his dog into the ring.
8. **Exhibitors are admonished** to make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this premium list. Rule books are available from The American Kennel Club, 8051 Arco Corporate Drive, Suite 100, Raleigh, NC 27617-3390, (919) 233-9767.
9. **The club, trial secretary, or their employees** will not be responsible for the loss of or damage to any dog exhibited, whether the result of accident or other causes and in addition assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by an exhibitor or handler. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.
10. **The American Kennel Club will collect** a \$.50 Recording Fee and a \$3.00 Event Service Fee for the first entry of each dog in obedience. A \$3.50 Event Service fee will be collected for the first entry of each dog in rally. In addition, a \$3.00 Event Service will be collected for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes in all AKC licensed and member club events. These fees are to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Sec. 2).
11. **All rights to TELEVISION, VIDEOTAPE, ADVERTISE, PHOTOGRAPH, PROMOTE** or otherwise exploit this event are vested in the CLUB, or in persons whom assignments of each rights have been made in writing by the Club. All persons and animals on the showgrounds at any time while the show is in progress, do by attending this show or participating therein, grant to the Club the right to photograph, televise, videotape, audiotape or otherwise use their likeness and voice in any manner without further release or consent.

CANINE GOOD CITIZEN TESTING

9am to 3pm

Saturday and Sunday

The AKC's Canine Good Citizen program is the gold standard of behavior for dogs in our communities. Almost one million dogs, both purebred and mixed breed, have participated in the program since it began in 1989.

CGC Test Items

- Test 1: Accepting a Friendly Stranger. The dog will allow a friendly stranger to approach and speak to the handler (the dog owner) in a natural, everyday situation.
- Test 2: Sit Politely for Petting. The dog will allow a friendly stranger to pet it while it is out with the handler.
- Test 3: Appearance and Grooming. The dog will permit someone to check its ears and front feet, as a groomer or veterinarian would do.
- Test 4: Out for a Walk (walking on a loose lead). Following the evaluator's instructions, the dog will walk on a loose lead (with the handler/owner).
- Test 5: Walking Through a Crowd. The dog will walk through a small crowd of pedestrians, passing in close proximity to at least three people.
- Test 6: Sit and Down on Command and Stay in Place. The dog must demonstrate sit AND down on command, then the owner chooses the position for leaving the dog in the stay.
- Test 7: Coming When Called. The dog will come when called by the handler (from 10 feet away on leash).
- Test 8: Reaction to Another Dog. The dog will behave politely around other dogs. Two handlers and their dogs approach each other from a distance of about 20 feet, stop, shake hands and exchange pleasantries.
- Test 9: Reaction to Distractions. The evaluator will select and present two distractions such as dropping a chair, etc.
- Test 10: Supervised Separation. This test demonstrates that your dog can be left with a trusted person. The evaluator will hold your dog's leash while you go out of sight for three minutes.

**Your dog will be evaluated by an official AKC evaluator.
Sign up at trials or pre-register by contacting Twyla.**

Once your dog passes the CGC test, you'll be able to select one of these two choices:

CGC as a Title. Get the official AKC CGC title for your dog. The processing fee is \$20. You will receive the CGC certificate, be able to use the suffix "CGC" after your dog's name, and CGC will be added to your dog's title record. To get the official AKC title, your dog must be registered or listed with the AKC (and have a number of one of these three types: AKC number, PAL, or AKC Canine Partners). This is because to create titles, we attach them to the dog's number.

CGC certificate only. Get a CGC certificate only without the official AKC CGC title. The processing fee is \$10. CGC will not be added to your dog's title record.

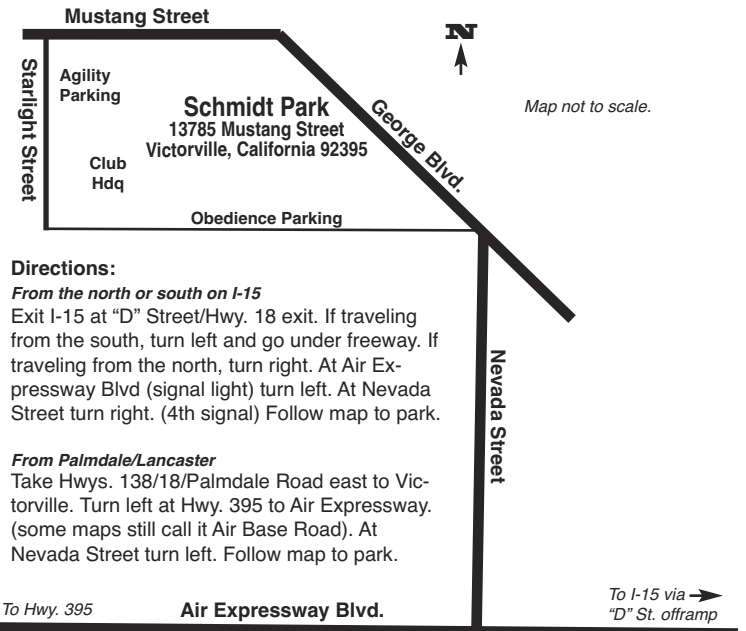

This fabulous location for the first November Agility Trials and Obedience/Rally Trials of the Apple Valley Kennel Club is situated on the grounds of the former historic George Air Force Base, which was closed in 1993. George AFB had a prominent place in training Air Force pilots who participated in testing our aircraft and fighting for our country in WWII, the Korean conflict, the Vietnam War and during peace time. The base is now the site of the Southern California Logistics Base. It is currently being slowly utilized by commercial enterprise as well as the California Air National Guard's 196th Reconnaissance Squadron, which operates a MQ-1 Predator remotely piloted aircraft training facility.
